ACADEMIC STANDING

A student either currently or formerly enrolled, is either: in "good standing," "on probation," or "suspended".

- A. "Good Standing" signifies that the student is doing satisfactory work and is eligible to continue, return or transfer.
- B. <u>"Probation"</u> is an intermediate status between good standing and suspension. It refers to any student whose college work does not meet scholastic conditions as set forth on the following pages.
- C. <u>"Suspended"</u> represents an involuntary separation of the student from the District for unsatisfactory school work. The period of suspension may be one or more semesters.
