

HONOR ROLL AND GRADUATION HONORS

Northern Wyoming Community College District students who achieve high scholastic grades are honored by being placed on the President's Honor Roll, the Vice President's Honor Roll or the Part-time Honor Roll at the end of each regular semester and by receiving Honors distinction at graduation.

I. Honor Roll:

- A. President – Maintain full-time enrollment by completing 12 or more college-level credit hours with letter grades of A or S and a semester GPA of 4.0 for all classes. Credits counted in S graded classes may not exceed one credit.
- B. VICE PRESIDENT – Maintain full-time enrollment by completing 12 credit hours or more with letter grades of A, B, C, OR S and a semester GPA OF 3.5 or higher. Credits counted in S graded classes may not exceed one credit.

A. Part-Time Honor Roll:

- A. 12 or more cumulative credit hours from previous semesters with letter grades of A, B, C, D, F, S, or U and a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- B. At least 6 credit hours with letter grades of A, B, C, or S in the current semester. Credits counted in S graded classes may not exceed one credit.
- C. Students dropping from full-time to part-time status in transcribed classes do not qualify.

B. Graduation Honors:

- A. "With High Honors" - Minimum cumulative transferable GPA of 3.75.
- B. "With Honors" - Minimum cumulative transferable GPA of 3.50.
- C. Associate Degree recipients must complete a minimum of 32 hours at NWCCD that apply to graduation requirements.
- D. Certificate recipients must complete a minimum of one-half of their required courses at NWCCD.
- E. Credit awarded for advanced placement, CLEP, USAFI, and other non-traditional forms of advanced placement does not apply to the requirements in A and B.
