Cost of Attendance (COA)

The costs listed in the COA chart (on the other side of this form) reflect estimates for the average expenses for students in each category. The estimated cost for tuition and fees is based upon 15 credits during the 17/18 academic year (includes fall 2017 and spring 2018 semesters). If you plan to enroll for more (or less) than 15 credits adjust your tuition and book costs so that you will have a more accurate estimate of your expenses.

If you receive any federal financial aid your total amount of assistance from all sources (includes student and parent loans, work-study, scholarships, tuition benefits, athletic scholarships, et cetera) cannot exceed your COA. If your total amount of assistance exceeds your COA, federal law requires the College to reduce your financial aid to eliminate the overage.

The student's actual costs for housing, meals, personal expenses and transportation will vary depending upon the options selected and the individual's spending habits.

The book allowance is based upon an average across all programs except those having a higher cost for supplies.

Students who enroll in the following programs should anticipate that their costs for books and supplies will exceed the average amount listed in the COA chart. The amounts in the chart below **replace** the books/supplies cost for the listed programs. The **total** estimated amounts for books and supplies are listed below:

All items listed in the COA are considered to be good faith estimates and are subject to change.
