

NWCCD 2014 – 2015 Graduates

Northern Wyoming Community College District (NWCCD) includes summer, fall and spring graduates in a reporting year. Some students complete more than one credential during a reporting year but are shown only by their primary program in the chart below. Data are gathered from graduates just prior to Commencement. Because of timing, employment is often not yet known. Therefore, we will update this table this fall as more information is received from graduates. We use the National Student Clearinghouse to identify students who are continuing their education. Program faculty are often able to help us when we are unable to connect with a graduate. But in some cases we are not able to identify the occupation of graduates. NWCCD does not have a placement office, and Wyoming workforce agencies do not share job placement information with colleges.

NWCCD offers both technical training and academic transfer programs. Fifty-three percent of the graduates plan to continue their education next fall. At this time we are unable to identify the plans of fifteen percent of our graduates.
