

## **Parking**

Parking is available on the south side of the Whitney Building in the spots marked above. ## Dental Hygiene Services

#### Services

Sheridan College offers a full-service Dental Hygiene Clinic open to the public. We provide patient education and individualized therapeutic services to help patients reach their oral health goals.


#### THE FOLLOWING SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE:

- Oral Prophylaxis teeth cleaning
- Topical Fluoride Application must be preceded by prophylaxis at the same appointment time
- **Full Mouth X-ray Survey** x-rays will be sent to your dentist upon request, by the dentist or you
- **Pit and Fissure Sealants** to prevent tooth decay in grooves of teeth
- Athletic Guards & Whitening Trays

The SC Dental Hygiene Clinic offers these services at a reduced cost. Our sophomore and junior students in the dental hygiene program provide the services in a learning environment. Students are supervised by faculty members and a clinic dentist.

Students work more slowly than experienced graduates. Patients are frequently required to return for completion of services. Persons whose schedules will not allow them to return for further appointments should not plan to use the SC Dental Hygiene Clinic.

All persons whose dental hygiene care requirements are consistent with the program's educational goals are eligible for care. The SC Dental Hygiene Clinic provides nondiscriminatory treatment regardless of race, color, religion, gender, sexual orientation, nationality or ethnic origin, age, military status, or disability. This includes individuals who may have or have been exposed to human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) and/or hepatitis B virus (HBV).



#### Children

Children and adolescents are accepted for treatment in the SC Dental Hygiene Clinic. Minors under the age of 18 must have a parent or legal guardian register with them at the reception desk. Parent or legal guardian must stay at the clinic until the health history and treatment plan have been reviewed and signed (approximately 45 minutes). A health history, treatment plan, and release form are required.

Parents should not leave the SC Dental Hygiene Clinic reception area while a child is being treated in the clinic.

Children may not accompany parents receiving treatment into the clinic area or be left unattended in the SC Dental Hygiene Clinic reception area. Arrangements should be made to leave children at home who are not receiving treatment at the Dental Hygiene Clinic.

Standard precautions are taken for every patient seen at the Sheridan College Dental Hygiene Clinic and outside rotations. These precautions include personal protective equipment, sterilization of all instruments, and disinfection protocol are followed to help prevent the spread of blood-borne pathogens and infectious diseases.

## **Appointments**

Appointments are scheduled for 8:30 a.m. and 1:15 p.m. and last approximately 3 hours. X-ray appointment times vary and last approximately 1.5 hours. Please arrive 15 minutes early to complete paperwork.
