Degrees and Certificates

The Northern Wyoming Community College District (NWCCD) is authorized to award the following degrees to students who meet the necessary requirements: Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, Associate of Fine Arts, Associate of Applied Science, Associate Degree in Nursing, and Bachelor of Applied Science.

A degree at NWCCD encompasses both general education and program level requirements. General education requirements include social, intellectual, and civic components. Program courses fulfill specialized requirements for transfer to baccalaureate programs or entry into the workforce. Upon completion of a degree, NWCCD students will possess the ability to acquire and apply knowledge, think critically, and communicate effectively.

In addition, all programs will be subject to systematic regular reviews to ensure quality, programmatic efficacy, and that student learning outcomes at the course, program, and institutional levels are being met in accordance with the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) *Teaching and Learning: Evaluation and Improvement* (CRRT.B.10.020).

NWCCD is also authorized to award the Certificate of Completion to students who demonstrate the knowledge and skills required to perform the necessary job-related functions to be successful in entry-level positions in a specified job category or group of job categories.
