Anti-Hazing Policy

Northern Wyoming Community College District complies with the Stop Campus Hazing Act. This act requires institutions of higher education that participate in federal student aid programs to report hazing incidents.

Hazing in any form is strictly prohibited, as it endangers the physical and psychological well-being of individuals and is contrary to the values of the institution.

Hazing is defined as an act that endangers the mental or physical health or safety of a student, or that destroys or removes public or private property, for the purpose of initiation, admission into, affiliation with, or as a condition for continued membership in a group or organization. Participation or cooperation by the person(s) being hazed does not excuse the violation. Failing to intervene, failing to report, or discouraging to report those acts may also violate this policy.

Hazing includes actions that cause embarrassment, harassment, or emotional or physical harm, regardless of the individual's willingness to participate.
