REQUIREMENTS HAVE RECENTLY CHANGED. PLEASE READ CAREFULLY:

There are currently NO prerequisites or documents that must be completed before the class begins.

Apply for general admission to NWCCD (if not a current student) at www.sheridan.edu If this is the only class you are taking, apply as 'Non-degree seeking or professional development'.

Register: Once accepted, contact Enrollment Service (307-675-0115) and see if you need to meet with an advisor to get registered for NRST 1510. Make sure to choose the correct section you wish to take (see schedule).

Additional Course Information:

- The class consists of six (6) weeks or fourteen (14) weeks of ONLINE learning AND five (5) IN-PERSON days for lab skills in the classroom and on-site clinicals. These dates may vary.
- Access to a computer with internet capability is required for this class, and students must use your college-assigned email.
- Students must purchase a software license online at www.ICEV.com or a HealthCenter21 software license from the college bookstore. The instructor will provide you with a registration code.
- **Students will be expected to access and utilize the college's online LMS (Canvas) for the duration of the class.**
- Students should expect to spend an average of 6 hours per week for the semester long course and 14 hours per week for the shorter course with on the online portion of this class. The schedule for the in-person days will be announced during the class.
- Students admitted or readmitted to the class will comply with current course guidelines and requirements. A student may be readmitted to the course one time only.
- All in-person meetings will take place at Sheridan College in the Health Science Building Rm W185.
- Applicants with questions or concerns regarding future certifications based on results of the criminal background check or drug screen should contact the course instructor and/or Wyoming State Board of Nursing to discuss. Admission to the nursing assistant course is not a guarantee of eligibility to become certified.
