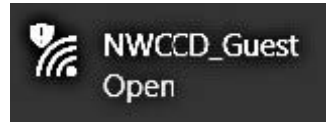
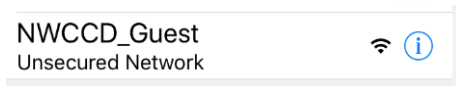
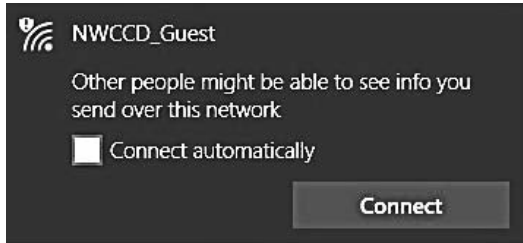




Connecting to NWCCD Guest Wireless

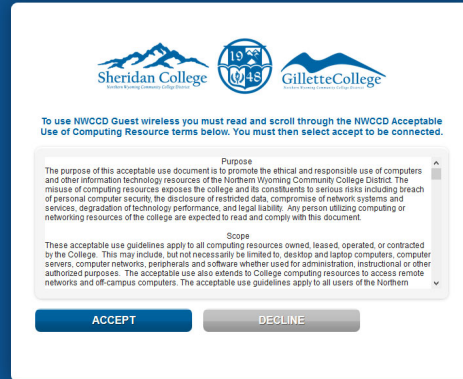
Guest wireless is available once you have connected and accepted the **NWCCD Acceptable Use of Computing Resource Terms**.

To connect to NWCCD_Guest Wireless

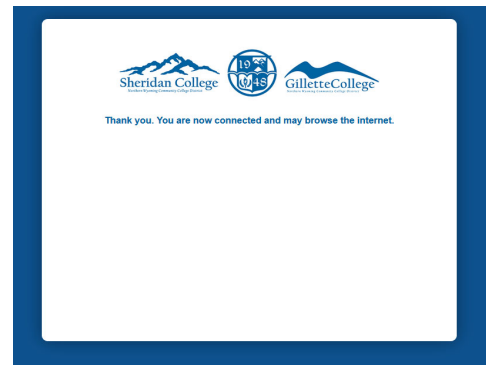
