## Annual Enrollee Success Rates:

Enrollee success is defined as the total number of “A,” “B,” “C,” and “S” grades from credit classes divided by the total number of “A,” “B,” “C,” “S,” “D,” “F,” “U,” and “W” grades expressed as a percentage. Grades are defined in Series 6010.6 of the College Policy & Procedures Handbook as follows:

| Grade | Definition          |
|-------|---------------------|
| A     | Exceptional         |
| B     | Very Good           |
| C     | Acceptable, Average |
| D     | Poor                |
| F     | Failure             |
| S     | Satisfactory        |
| U     | Unsatisfactory      |
| W     | Official Withdrawal |

Summer, fall and spring terms are included in this rate. Below are the success rates for the four most recent years.

| Year        | Success Rate |
|-------------|--------------|
| 2021 – 2022 | 82.06%       |
| 2022 – 2023 | 81.07%       |
| 2023 – 2024 | 83.93%       |
| 2024 – 2025 | 84.24%       |
