



## **CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT at Sheridan College in Johnson County**

NRST 1510 Theory, Lab, & Clinical Course

**There are no prerequisites/documents needed prior to registering for class.**

**Apply for general admission to NWCCD (if not a current student) at [www.sheridan.edu](http://www.sheridan.edu)** If this is the only class you are taking, apply as 'Non-degree seeking or professional development'. **Register:** Once accepted, either contact Enrollment Service (307-675-0115) to register or access your Self-Service on the HUB and register for the section you would like for NRST 1510 (see schedule).

### **Additional Course Information:**

- The class consists of fourteen (14) weeks of ONLINE learning AND five (5) IN-PERSON days for lab skills in the classroom and on-site clinicals. These dates may vary.
- Access to a computer with internet capability is required for this class, and students must use your college-assigned email.
- Students must purchase a software license online at [www.ICEV.com](http://www.ICEV.com) or a HealthCenter21 software license from the college bookstore. The instructor will provide you with a registration code.
- Students will be expected to access and utilize the college's online LMS (Canvas) for the duration of the class.
- Students should expect to spend an average of 6 hours per week on the online portion of this class. The schedule for the in-person days will be announced during the class.
- Students admitted or readmitted to the class will comply with current course guidelines and requirements. A student may be readmitted to the course one time only.
- All in-person meetings will take place at the Sheridan College in Johnson County (SCJC) campus in Buffalo at 63 N. Burritt Ave., Buffalo, WY in room 105.
- Applicants with questions or concerns regarding future certifications based on results of the criminal background check or drug screen should contact the course instructor and/or Wyoming State Board of Nursing to discuss. Admission to the nursing assistant course is not a guarantee of eligibility to become certified.
