BE IT RESOLVED:

Sheridan College Code of Ethics for the College's president and College employees is hereby adopted:

COLLEGE EMPLOYEES

1. Will adhere to the highest ethical standards in the fulfillment of my job;
2. Will honor Board of Trustees' decisions, college policies, procedures and/or Board directives and the authority delegated to the President;
3. Will adhere to the mission and promote the goals and objectives of the College as stipulated by the Board of Trustees and administration;
4. Will exercise responsibility and self discipline in the matters of college affairs and strive to mold and maintain harmonious relations throughout the college community;
5. Will respect the positions and circumstances of the electorate and the Board of Trustees and shall honor my community, college and country.
