

Articulation Agreement between Northern Wyoming Community College District and the Institutions of the North Dakota University System

Introduction: This articulation agreement formally recognizes that the associate in arts/ associate in science degrees and the general education program of Northern Wyoming Community College District (NWCCD) are transferable to the colleges and universities of the North Dakota University System (NDUS).

Purpose: The purpose of this articulation agreement is to provide students with a seamless transfer from NWCCD to an NDUS institution following the completion of the NWCCD general education program or an associate in arts or associate in science program.

Motivating Values: Students will be well-served by this partnership, with the seamless transfer of NWCCD's associate in arts or associate in science degrees, or with the transfer of courses used to complete the NWCCD general education program.


Degree and General Education Program Acceptance:

1. This articulation agreement provides NWCCD students the opportunity to continue full-time or part-time study at any NDUS institution following the student's completion of an associate in arts or associate in science degree.
2. Students who graduate from NWCCD with an A.A. or A.S. degree are assured of an opportunity to continue their studies toward a bachelor's degree with junior (third year) standing, based on the number of completed credits (at least 60.)
3. Students who are verified to have completed NWCCD's general education core of at least 36 credits will also be granted credit for having met the lower division general education requirements at any receiving NDUS institution. Verifications of general education completion may be made by official transcript or by official correspondence from NWCCD.


Term: This agreement is effective following approval and signing by authorized representatives of the parties and will continue until terminated. The parties intend to review the agreement annually and update it as necessary or appropriate.

Termination and Revisions: Either party may terminate the agreement upon 30 days' notice in writing to the other. Any revision to the agreement must be in writing signed by both parties.




