Tuition, Standard Fees and Housing & Dining Fees

There are three categories of tuition and fees that are established and assessed: tuition, standard fees, and housing and dining fees. Current rates are available at www.sheridan.edu

1. **Tuition** is established by the Wyoming Community College Commission. Tuition is charged per credit up to 12 credits. Tuition is flat from 12 through 18 credits. After 18 credits, a per credit overload fee is charged. Tuition is refundable according to the Refund Procedure (5041.50).
2. **Standard Fees** are established and periodically revised by the District administration.
 - The following fees are assessed per credit hour as applicable:
 - Student
 - Institutional
 - Facility/Technology
 - Course
 - Online Course
 - Overload
 - The following fees are flat fees and are assessed based on usage, applicable enrollment or specific situation:
 - Program
 - Course
 - Usage
 - Workforce Development and Community Service
 - Conferencing/Agri-Park
 - Placement or Industry Testing
 - Late
 - Non-Sufficient Funds
 - Stop Payment
 - Miscellaneous
 - Unreturned equipment or uniforms
 - Library Fine
3. **Housing and Dining Fees** are charged to students who live on campus. District administration establishes these fees annually and may be different for each campus.
 - There are also special fees that apply only to on-campus residents. They may include the following fees:
 - Laundry
 - Resident Hall Activities
 - Administrative
 - Cancellation
