I. Musical Gear

1. Instrument and all related supplies:

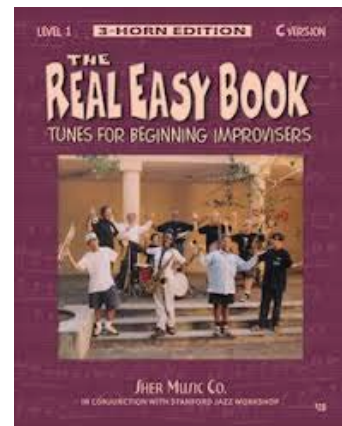
Saxes:	Instrument, Mouthpiece, Extra Reeds, etc.
Brass:	Instrument, Mouthpiece, Valve Oil, Slide Lubricant
Guitar:	Instrument, Extra Strings, 1/4" Audio Cable
Bass:	Instrument, Extra Strings, 1/4" Audio Cable
Keyboard:	Keyboard and amp will be provided
Drums:	Sticks, Brushes, Hi-Hat Clutch Latin Percussion instruments if desired, Drum Set will be provided

2. Folding music stand and clothes pins or music clips

3. **The Real Easy Book (3 Horn Edition) – Volume I; arranged by Larry Dunlap - Published by Sher Music. (Price: approximately \$30.00)**

We will use this book for our combo rehearsals and performances. You will be able to use this book for your own combo performances after the camp as well! **Be sure to purchase the version that is in the transposition for YOUR INSTRUMENT:**

! DO NOT BRING !

- Food – all food and snacks will be provided, food in the cabins attracts animals
