Register: Once accepted, contact Enrollment Service (307-675-0115) and see if you need to meet with an advisor to get registered for NRST 1510. Make sure to choose the correct section you wish to take (see schedule).

Additional Course Information:

- The class consists of six (6) weeks of ONLINE learning AND five (5) IN-PERSON days for lab skills in the classroom and on-site clinicals. These dates may vary.
- Access to a computer with internet capability is required for this class, and students must use your college-assigned email.
- Students must purchase a HealthCenter21 software license from the college bookstore or online at www.sheridancshop.com. The instructor will provide you with an access code.
- Students will be expected to access and utilize the college's online LMS (Canvas) for the duration of the class.
- Students should expect to spend an average of 14 hours per week on the online portion of this class. The schedule for the in-person days will be announced during the class.
- Students admitted or readmitted to the class will comply with current course guidelines and requirements. A student may be readmitted to the course one time only.
- All in-person meetings will take place at the Sheridan College in Johnson County (SCJC) campus in Buffalo at 63 N. Burritt Ave., Buffalo, WY in room 105.
- Applicants with questions or concerns regarding future certifications based on results of the criminal background check or drug screen should contact the course instructor and/or Wyoming State Board of Nursing to discuss. Admission to the nursing assistant course is not a guarantee of eligibility to become certified.
