

Annual Enrollee Success Rates

Enrollee success is defined as the total number of “A,” “B,” “C,” and “S” grades from credit classes divided by the total number of “A,” “B,” “C,” “S,” “D,” “F,” “U,” and “W” grades. Grades are defined in Series 6010.6 of the College Policy & Procedures Handbook as follows:

Grade	Definition
A	Exceptional
B	Very Good
C	Acceptable, Average
D	Poor
F	Failure
S	Satisfactory
U	Unsatisfactory
W	Official Withdrawal

Terms included in this rate are summer, fall and spring. Below are the success rates for the four most recent years.

Year	Success Rate
2018 – 2019	84.19%
2019 – 2020	82.82%
2020 – 2021	81.78%
2021 – 2022	82.06%
